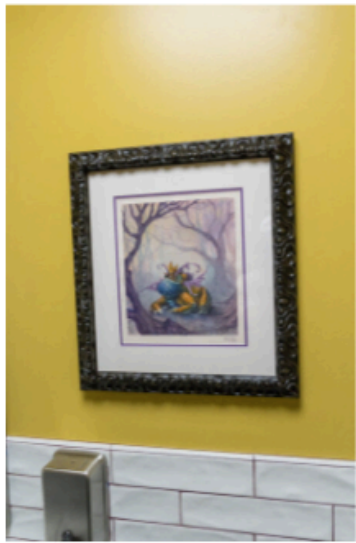

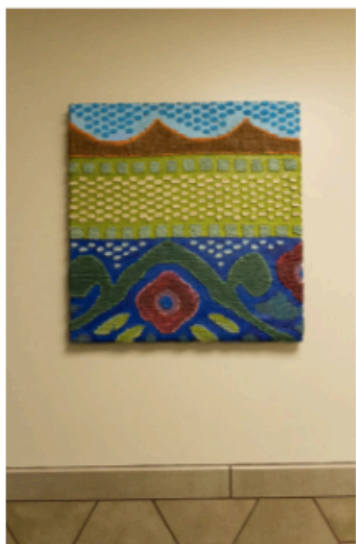


"Northern Hemisphere Constellation Map"

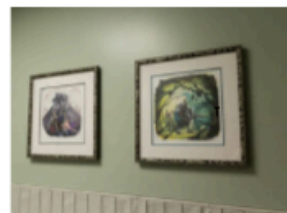

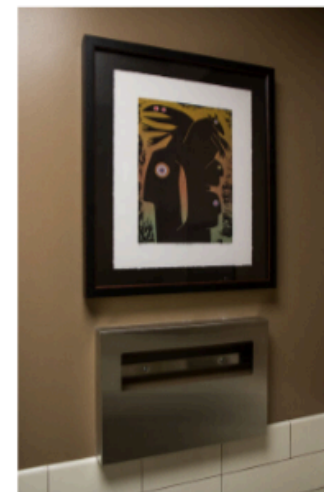

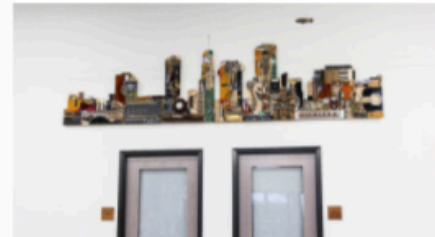

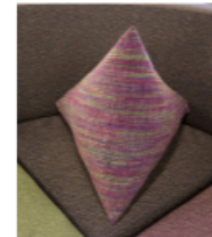

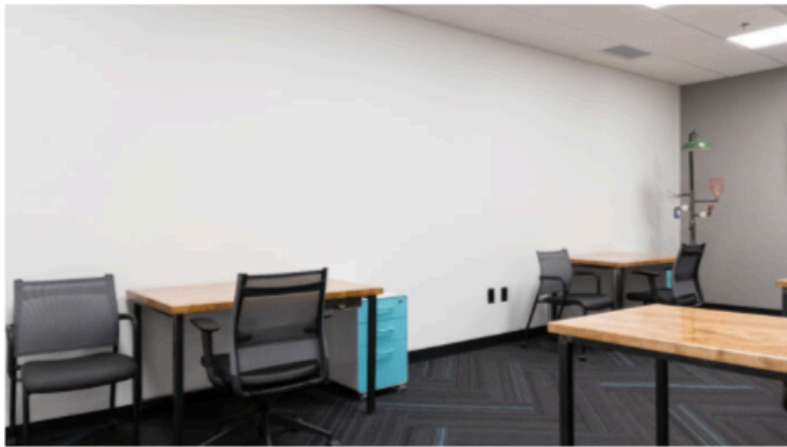
